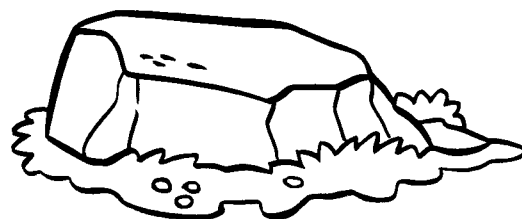
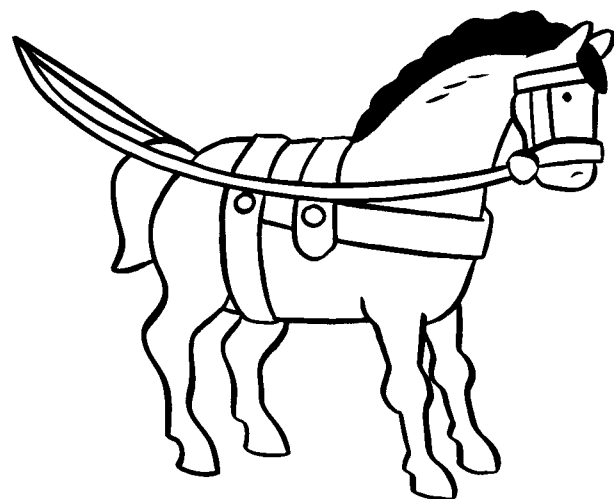
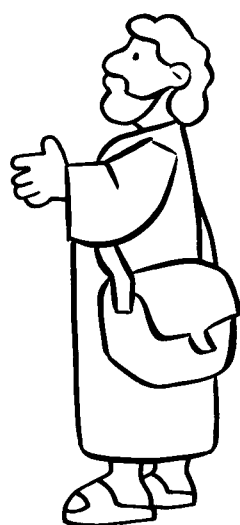
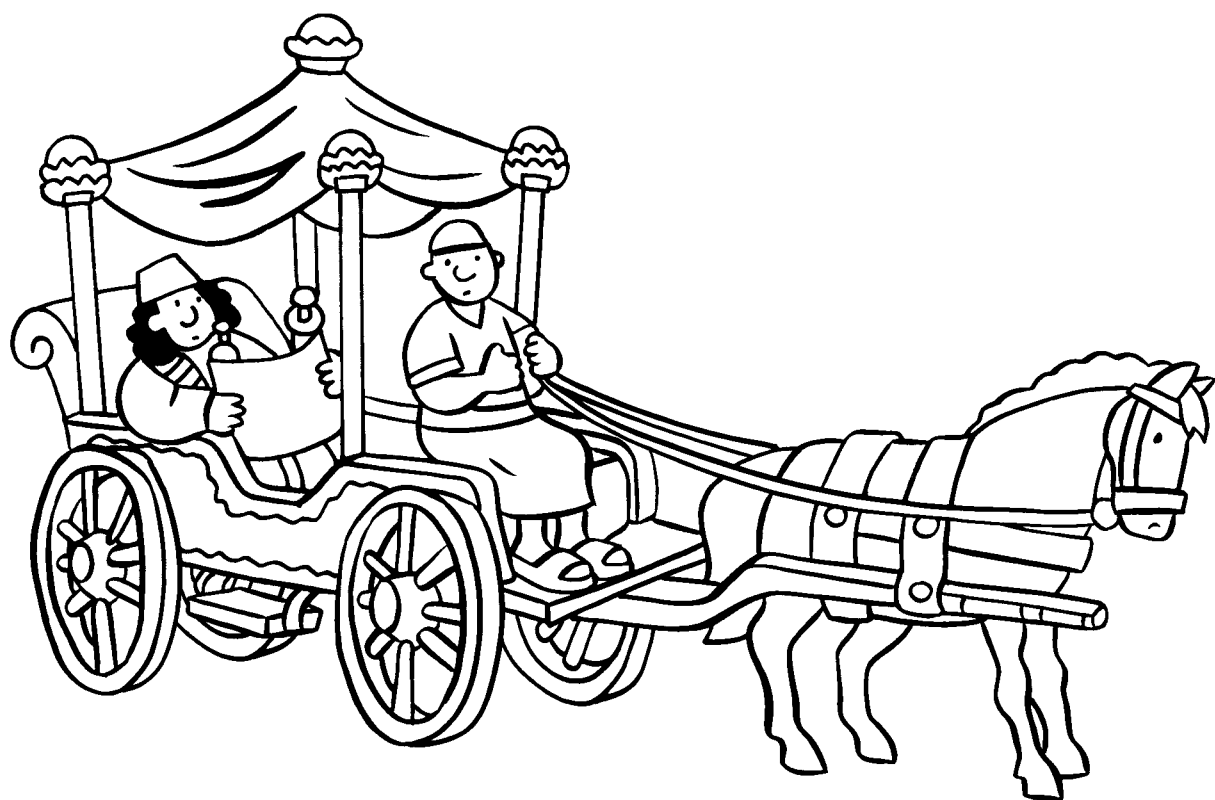
Ethiopia

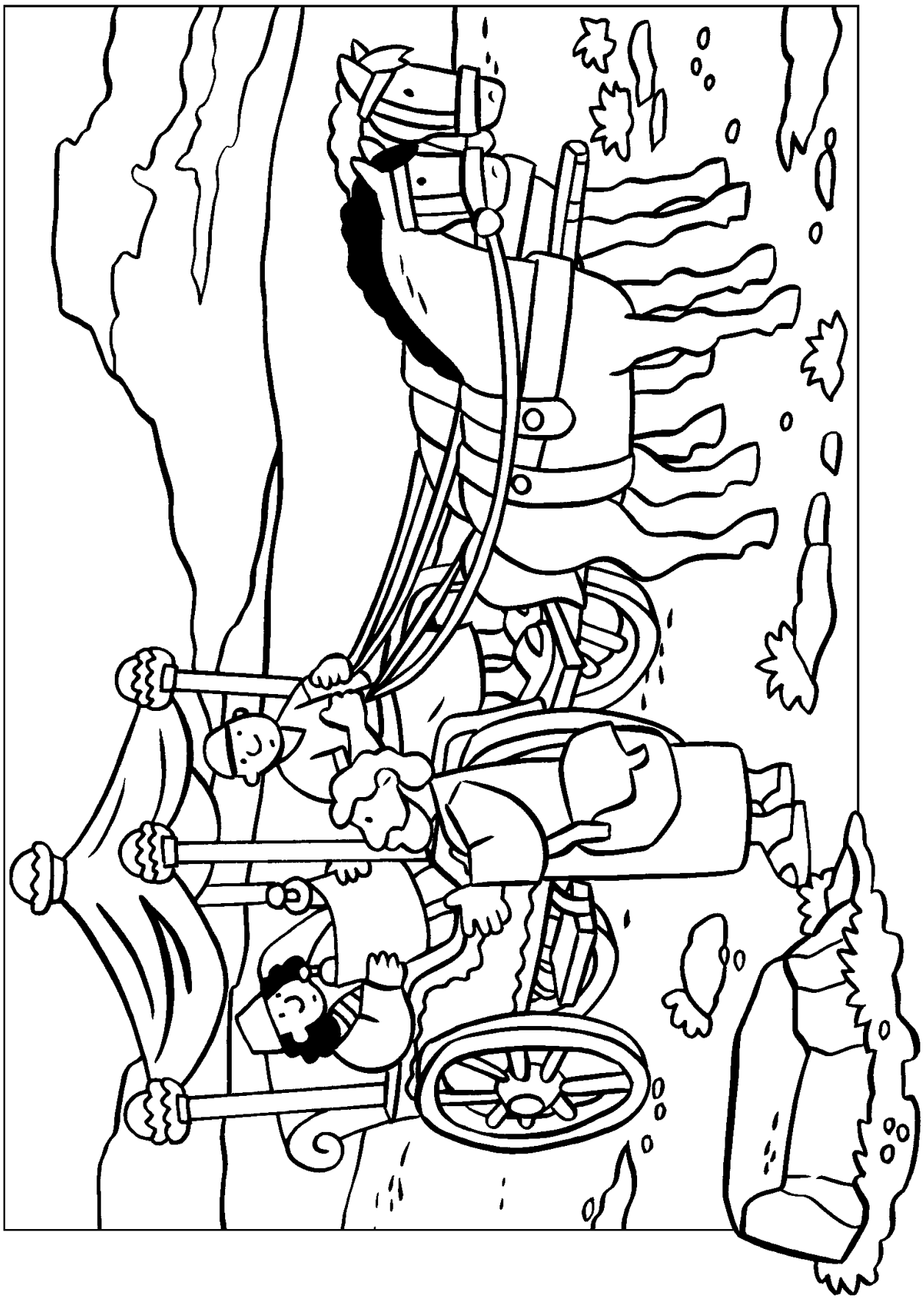


- Ethiopia is a very large country, about twice the size of Texas.

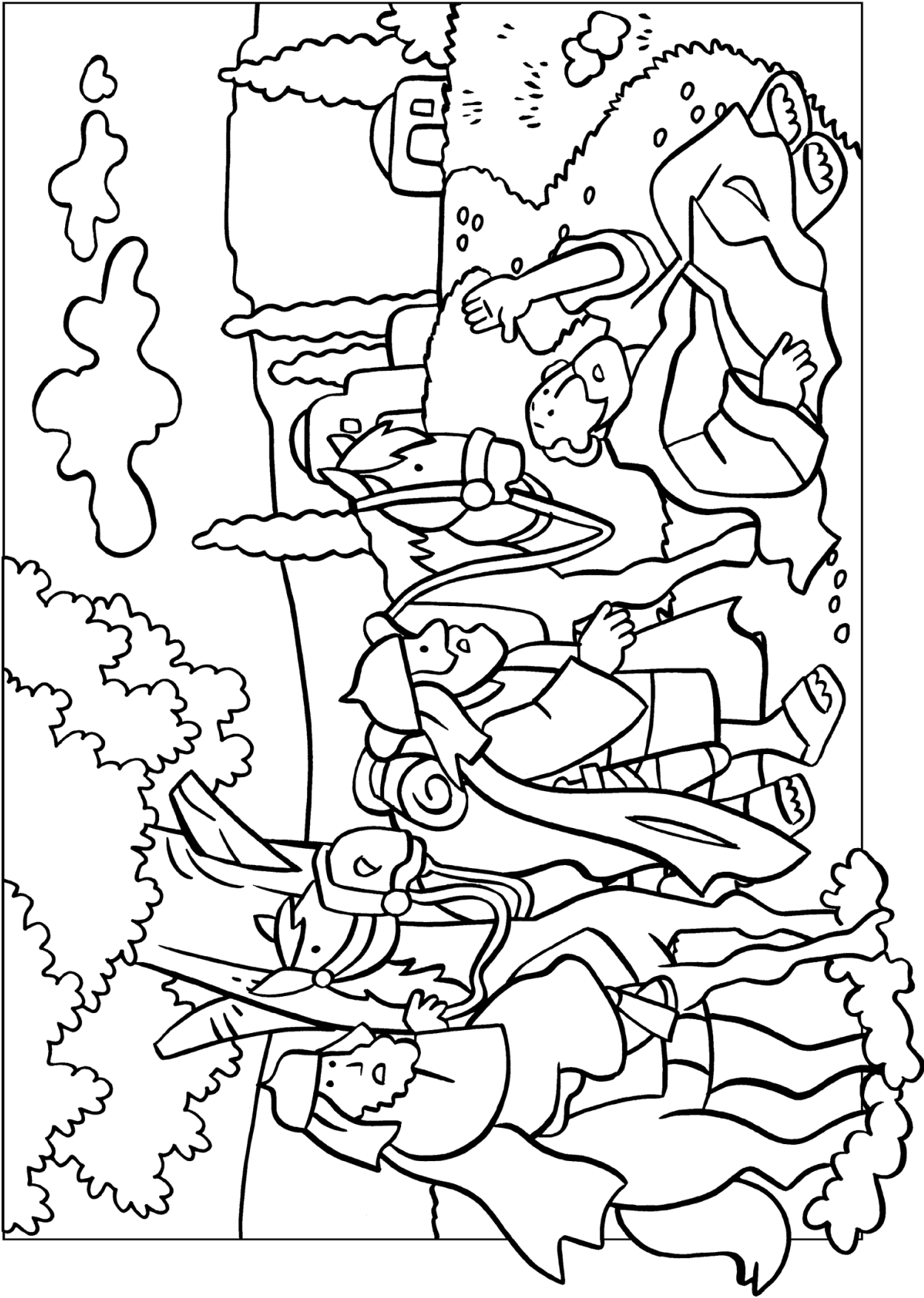


“Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ” (Rom. 5:1).

Reformation at Home: Read a favorite Bible story with your child at bedtime. Talk about the ways God shows His love and power in the story.

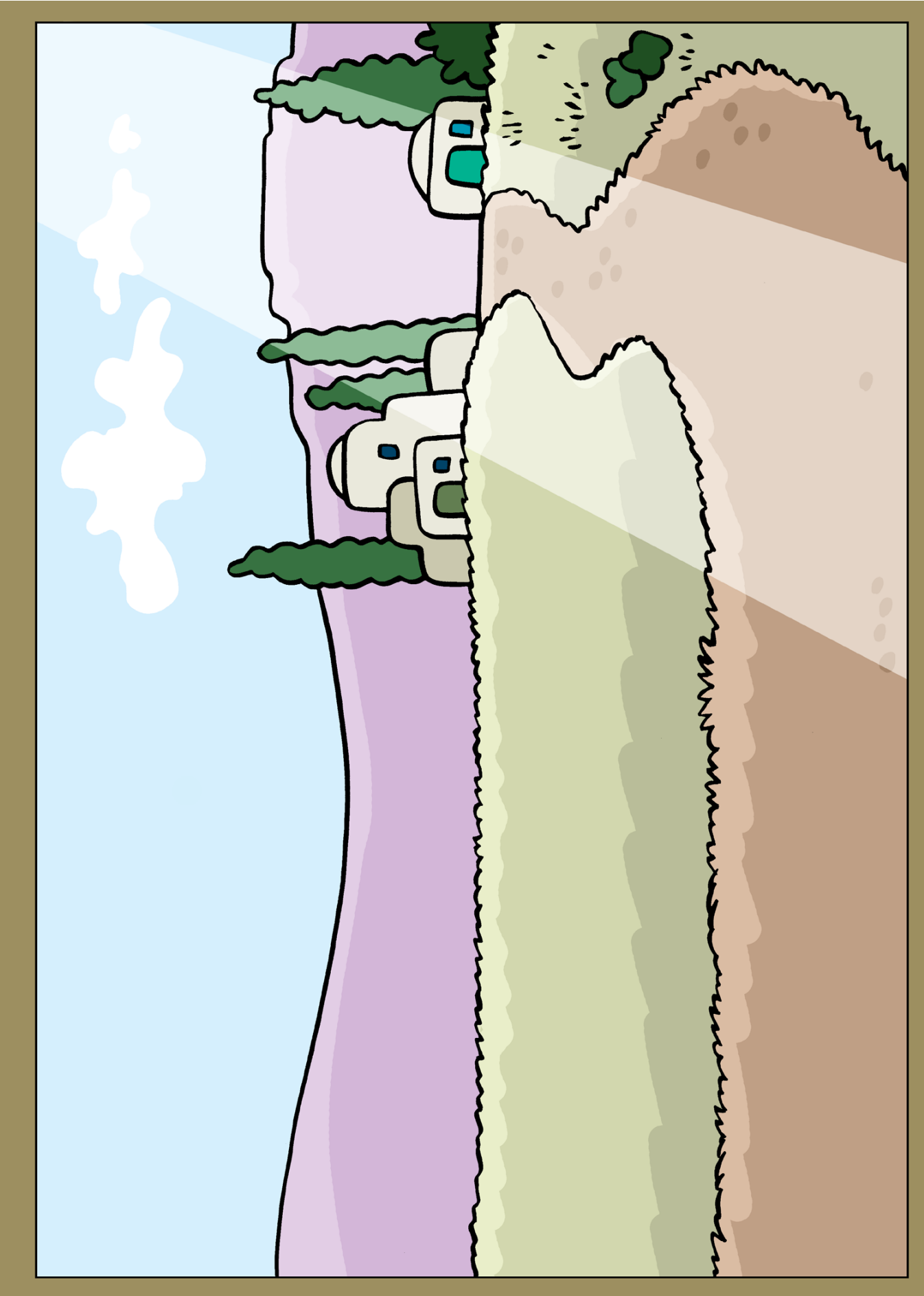

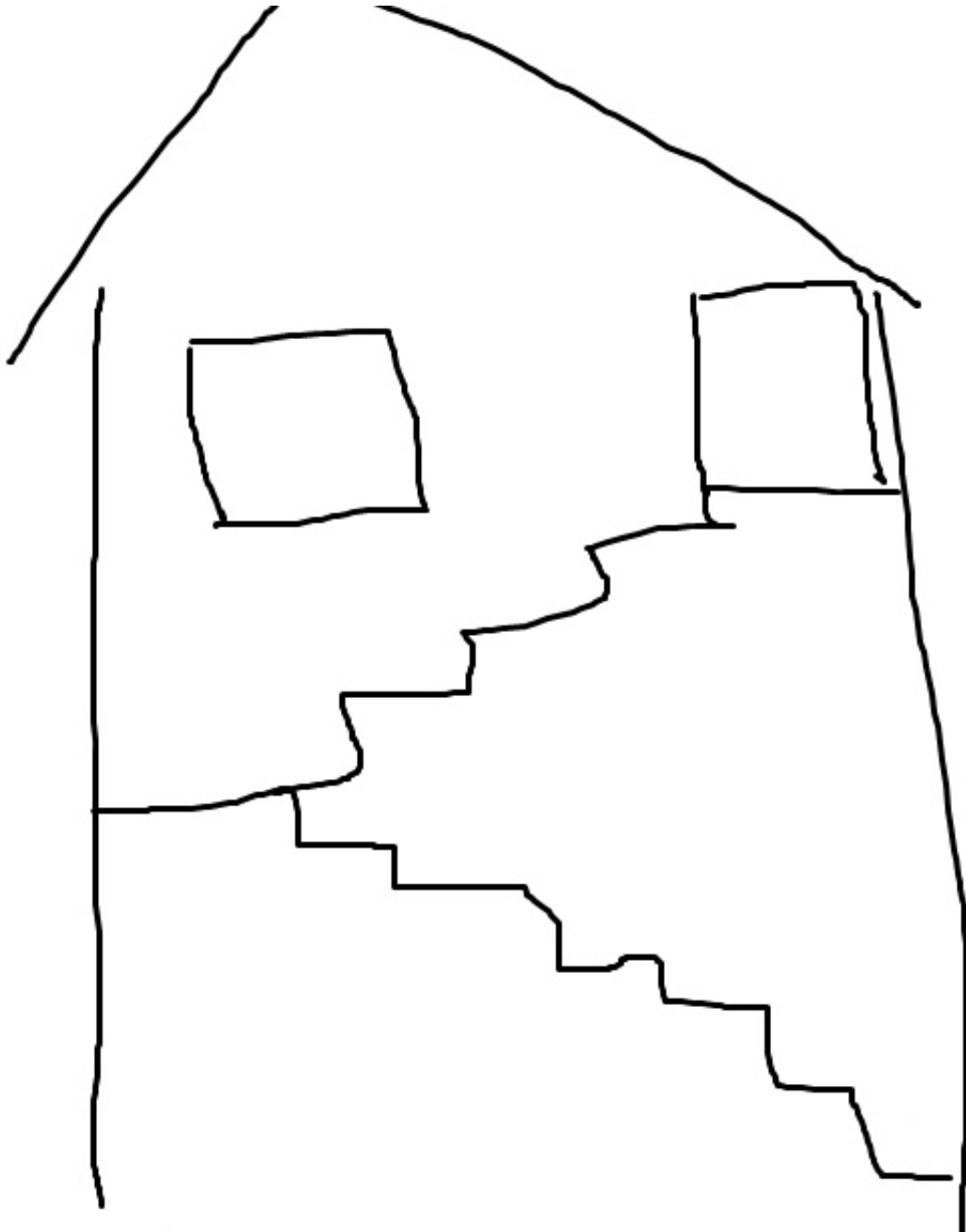






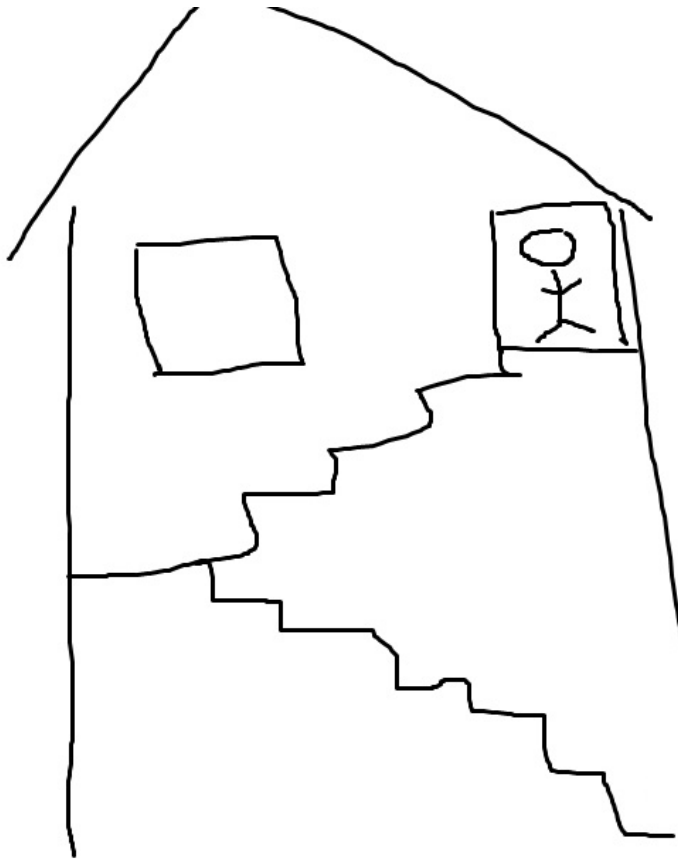
DAY 5 TEACHER RESOURCE

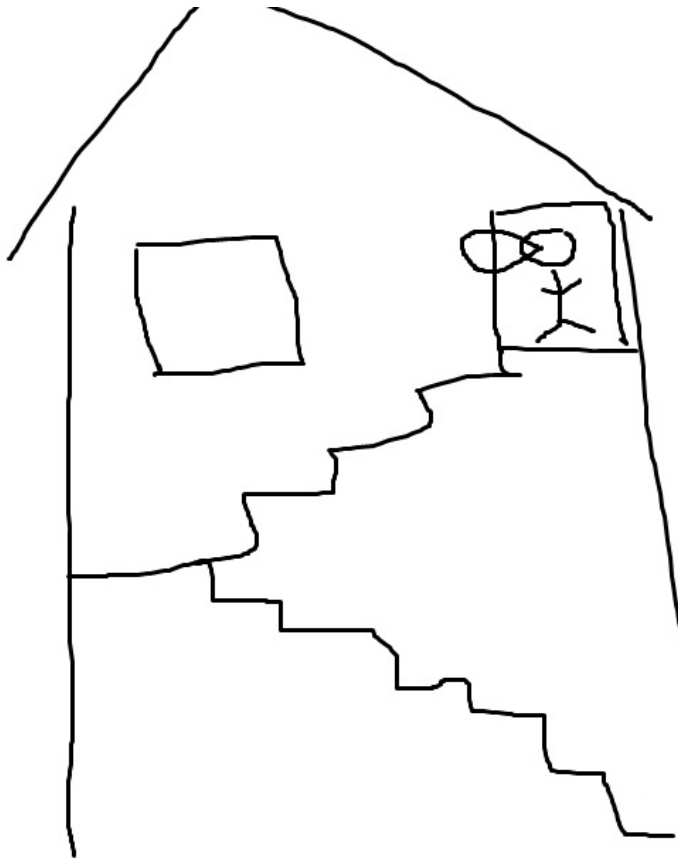


DAY 5 TEACHER RESOURCE

On Sunday, Paul gathered with Christians. They were gathered upstairs in a house. Paul was leaving on Monday. *Draw Paul in the open "doorway."*

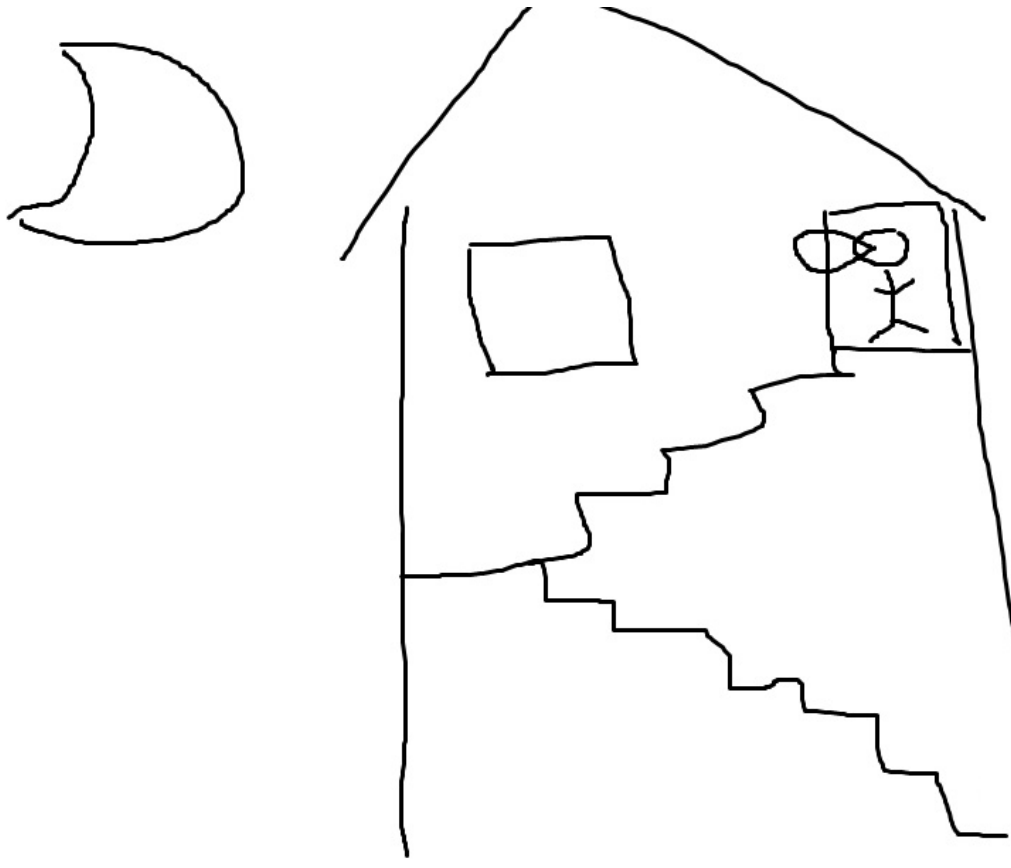


Paul told them God's Word. *Draw a speech bubble.*

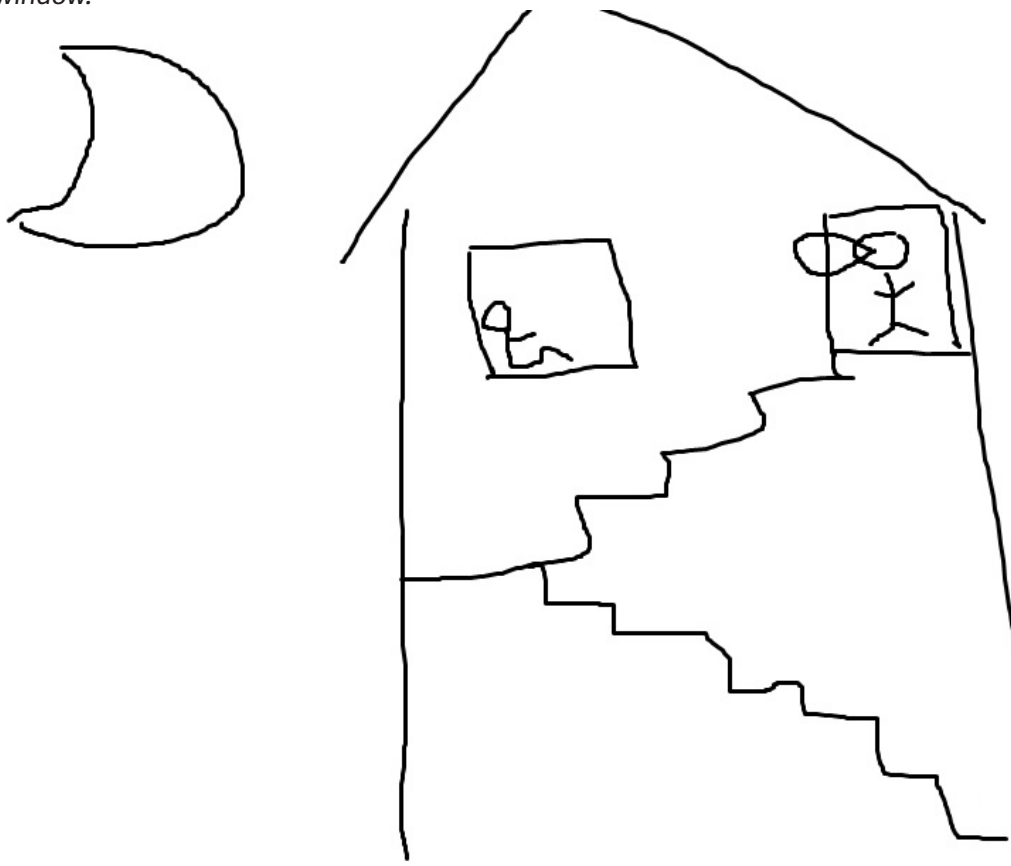


DAY 5 TEACHER RESOURCE

He told them God's Word until it was late at night on Sunday. *Draw a moon outside.*

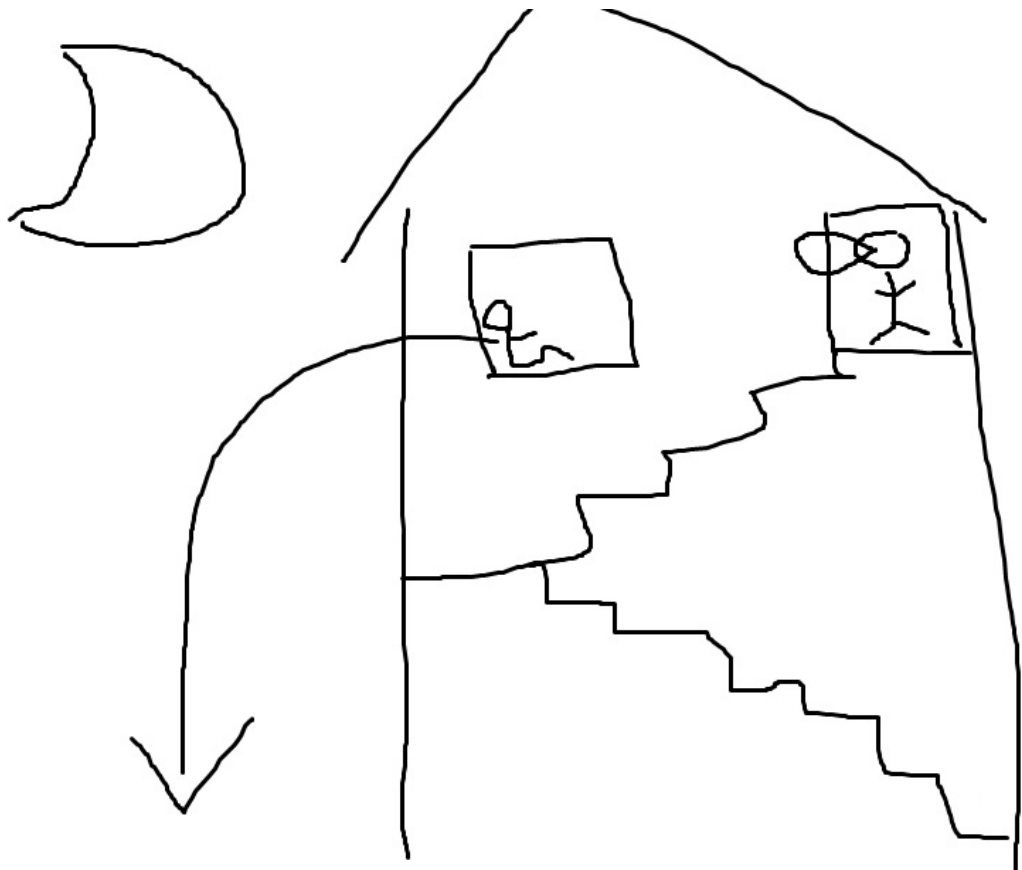

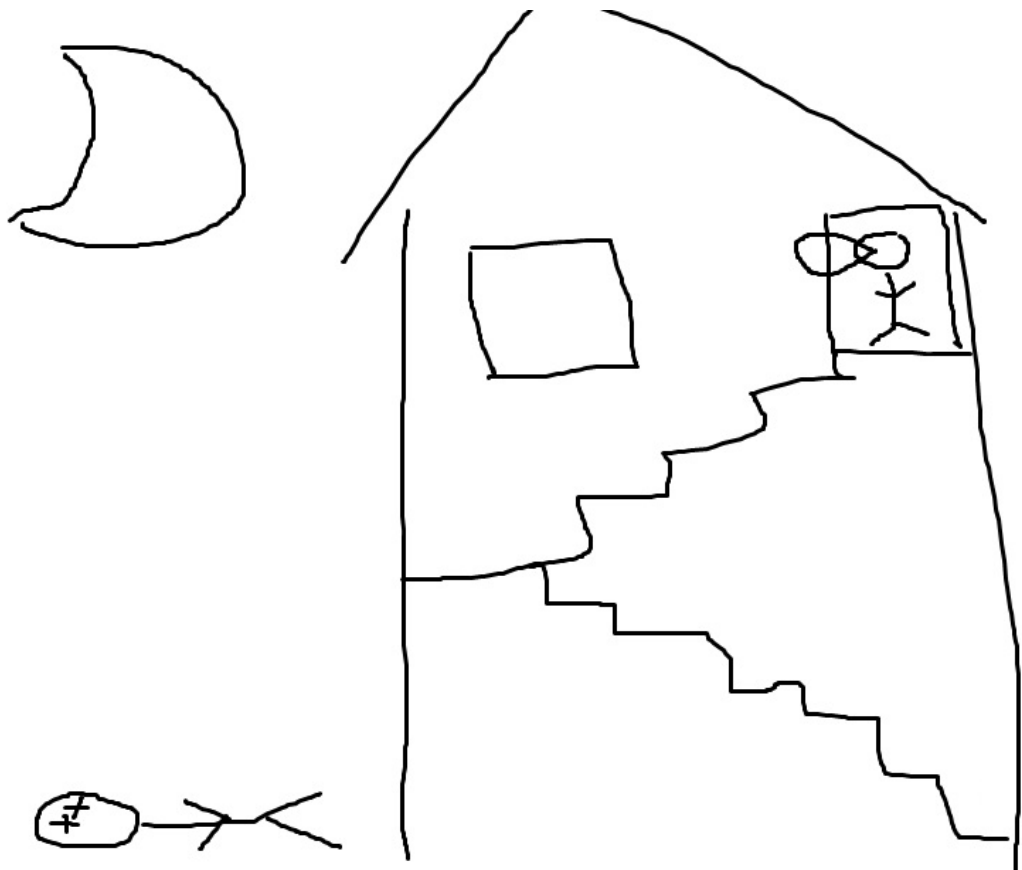

Draw an arrow from the boy to the ground.

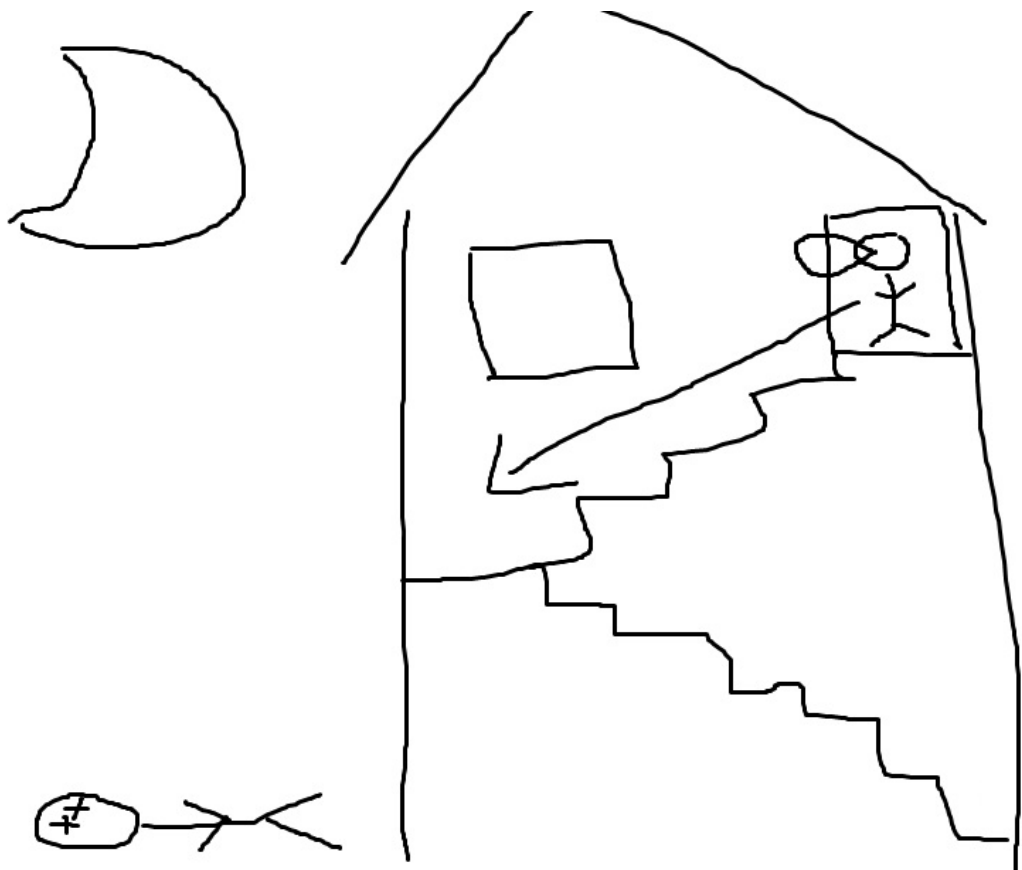


The boy fell down and died. *Erase the boy & the arrow and draw the boy on the ground.*

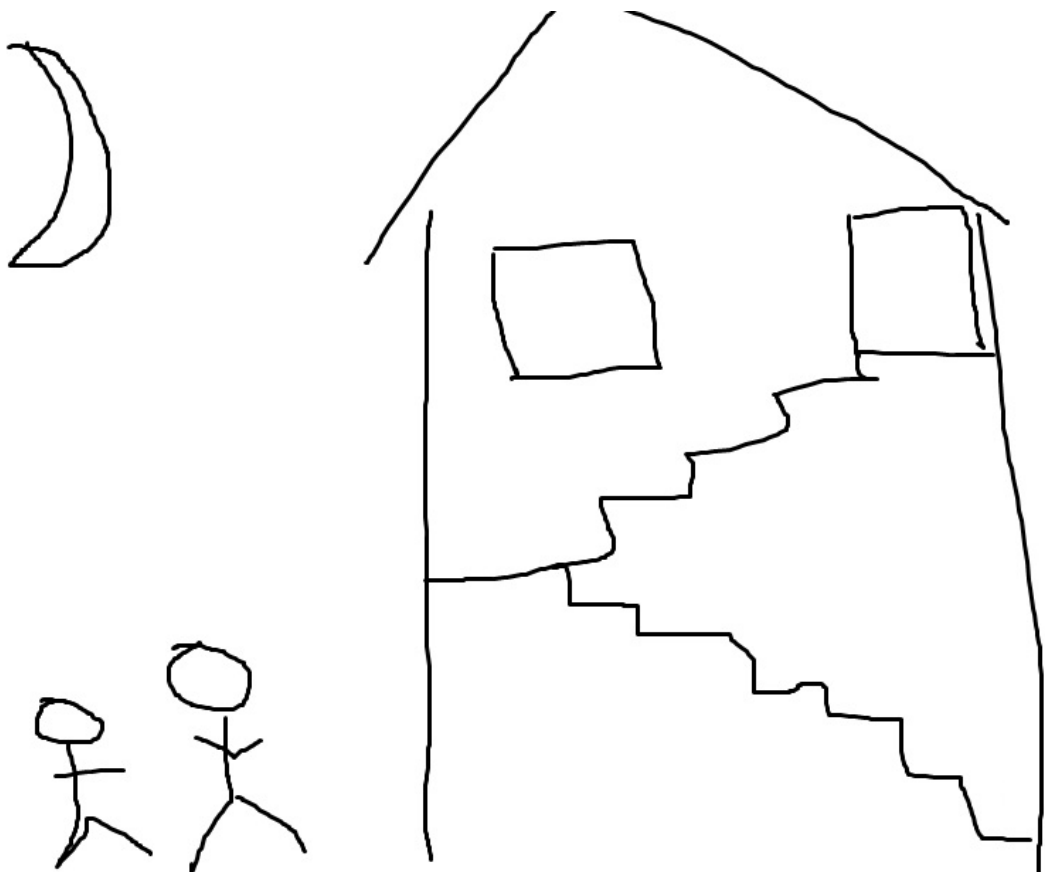


DAY 5 TEACHER RESOURCE

Paul went downstairs to the boy. *Draw an arrow down from Paul.*

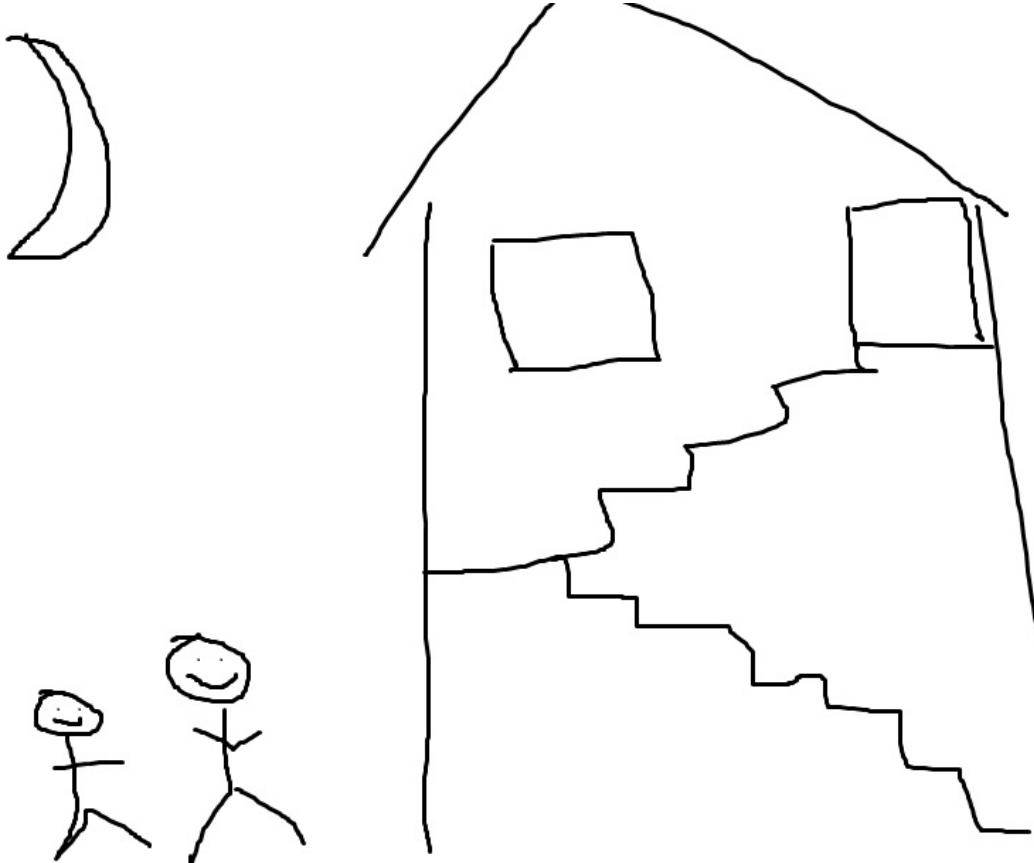


Paul picked him up. Paul said, "He is alive!" *Erase Paul, the arrow, and the boy. Draw Paul and the boy standing up.*

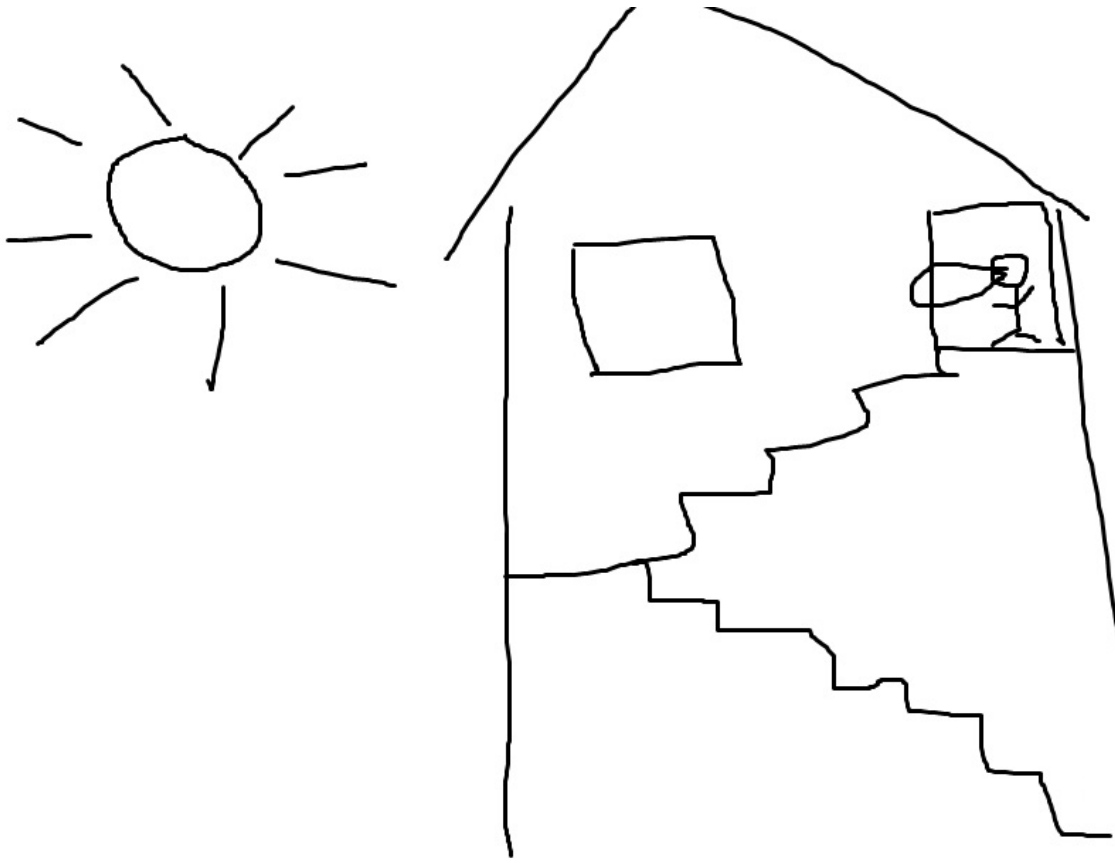


DAY 5 TEACHER RESOURCE
