The Rev. Jason and Anna Marie Steffenson serve the Lord as missionaries through The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS) in Italy, where Jason is a theological educator and church planter. In addition to helping with church-planting efforts throughout Italy, he teaches with the Luther Academy in Riga, Latvia.

Jason, Anna Marie, and sons Johanes and Immanuel are currently members of Trinity Lutheran Church, Ardmore, Okla. Jason grew up in Plattville, Ill., and has lived around the state. He holds a B.A. in theology from Concordia University, Nebraska, Seward, Neb. (2009), and an M.Div. from Concordia Seminary, St. Louis (2019). He has taken several trips to Israel, the West Bank and Jordan, where he volunteered in several capacities such as serving at a home for people with physical and mental disabilities. He also spent time

teaching English as a Second Language in Taiwan. Between 2019 and 2022, he served as pastor of both First Lutheran Church, Ada, Okla., and Hope Lutheran Church, Sulphur, Okla. From 2022 to 2024, he served as an LCMS missionary and theological educator in Tanzania. Jason enjoys making music, hiking, running, camping and learning languages.

Anna Marie is from Jerusalem and attended Concordia University, Nebraska. She double majored in studio art and business administration. Later, she lived and worked in Taiwan as an international business consultant. In 2013, she started her own small business: Fine Art by Anna Marie. Her artwork is in private, corporate, public, religious and royal collections throughout the world. She served as the president of the Ada Artist's Association, taught personal finance classes at her local pregnancy resource center and served on the Board of Directors for the LCMS Oklahoma District. In her free time, Anna Marie enjoys international affairs and all forms of fiber arts.
