The Rev. Nathaniel and Emma Jensen serve the Lord through The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS) in Kaiserslautern, Germany. Nathaniel is pastor of Kaiserslautern Evangelical Lutheran Church, which serves U.S. military members stationed in the area as well as other English speakers. In addition, Nathaniel works with the Synod's partner church in Germany to proclaim the Gospel to non-English speakers, and he serves as a mentor to seminary students throughout the region.

Nathaniel was born in St. Louis, Mo., and his home congregation is Peace Lutheran Church, St. Louis. He received a bachelor's degree in German and Theological Languages from Concordia University Wisconsin, Mequon, Wis.

Emma is from Sault Ste. Marie, Mich., and her home congregation is St. Barnabas Lutheran Church, Sault Ste. Marie. Nathaniel and Emma have two daughters, Agatha and Cecilia, who are with them on the mission field.
