The Rev. Micah Wildauer serves the Lord as a missionary through The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS) in Belize, based in the capital city of Belmopan. Micah serves as a church planter, working alongside a team of fellow missionaries and Belizean church leaders. He travels to preaching stations, catechizes the faithfully gathered through the Divine Service and Bible studies, and reaches out to the lost through home visits. Through these efforts, he seeks to help form self-sustaining congregations and a future church body. Micah also serves as an adjunct professor for *Seminario Concordia el Reformador*, the regional seminary located in the Dominican Republic, where he assists in

the pastoral formation of men throughout the Latin American region.

Micah was born in Bremen, Ind., and baptized at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Bremen. He is the son of two Lutheran school teachers. Before serving as an international missionary, Micah served as a dual parish pastor at Bethlehem Lutheran Church and Hope Lutheran Church, both located in Milwaukee (2006–2014).

Robin was born in Versailles, Mo., and baptized at Grace Lutheran Church in Versailles. She graduated from Northwest Missouri State University, Maryville, in 2008. Micah and Robin enjoy spending time with their four children: Samuel, Elizabeth, David and Lydia. The family enjoys trips to the park, wiffle ball, family gatherings and exploring the beautiful country in which they serve.
