Makia's desire to serve on the international mission field developed during a variety of short-term mission experiences, including shadowing an LCMS missionary in Europe (2024) and serving on mission trips to the Dominican Republic (2022 and 2023) and Thailand (2024). In her free time, Makia loves reading, crocheting and growing plants.
